TIMSS 2011 Science and Mathematics Item Review Committee

The TIMSS Science and Mathematics Item Review Committee (SMIRC) is an international panel of experts that provides advice about the mathematics and science assessments. SMIRC members met four times for TIMSS 2011. At the first meeting in London, England (March 2009), SMIRC reviewed the mathematics and science content frameworks and the field test items, together with their scoring guides, for field testing at the second meeting in Amsterdam, The Netherlands (August 2009). SMIRC reviewed field test results and made recommendations to the National Research Coordinators regarding which items to include in the 2011 mathematics and science assessments at the third meeting in Gothenburg, Sweden (June 2010).
