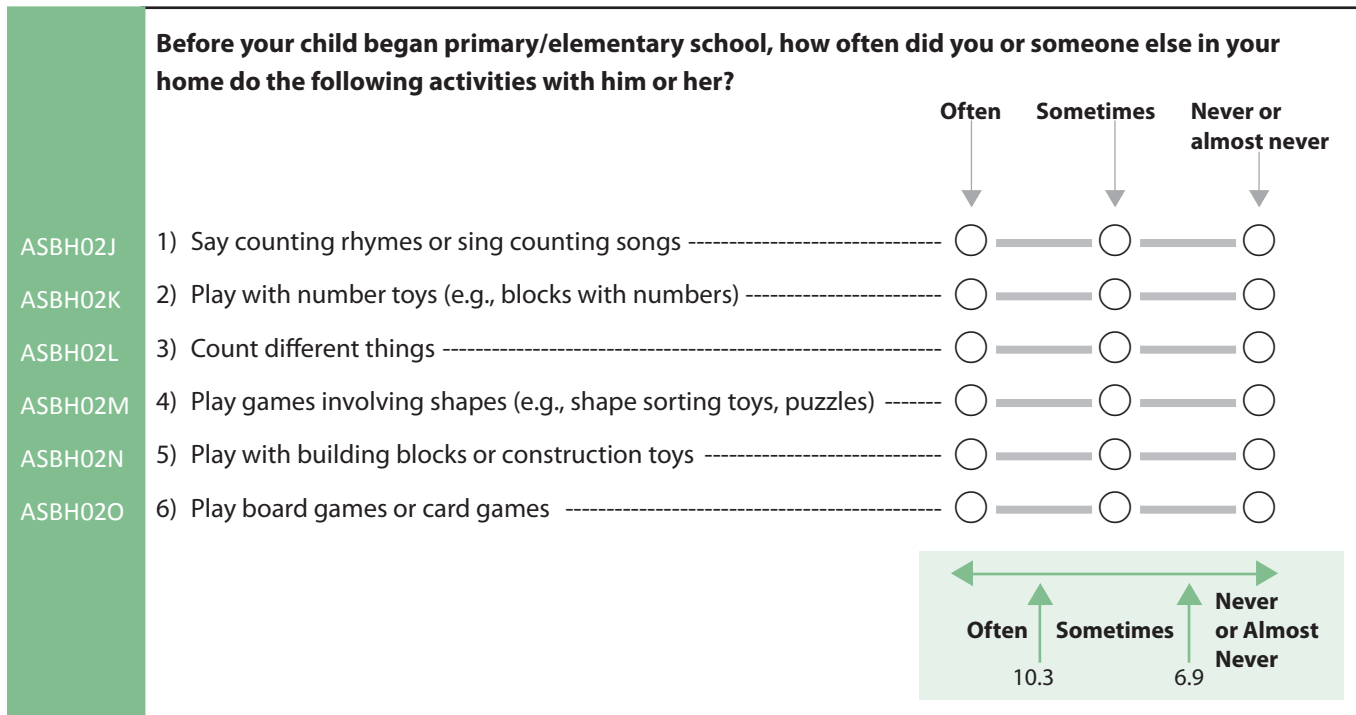

# The TIMSS 2011 Early Numeracy Activities Before Beginning Primary School Scale, Fourth Grade

The Early Numeracy Activities Before Beginning Primary School (ENA) scale was created based on parents' responses to the six statements described below. See [Creating and Interpreting TIMSS and PIRLS 2011 Context Questionnaire Scales](#) for more information on how the scales were formed. Because the ENA scale was derived using responses to items in the PIRLS Home Questionnaire, results reported in Exhibits 2–5 were estimated from the PIRLS 2011 data. Results reported in Exhibit 6 were estimated from the TIMSS 2011 data.
